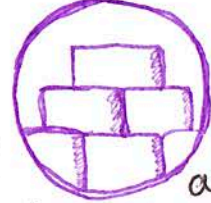


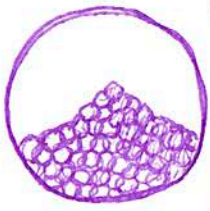
WHAT GOES INTO AN MMM SHALLOW WELL ?



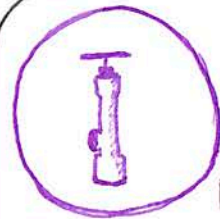
SAND GRAVEL



BRICK



Sand and gravel are collected and transported to the well-site by local villagers. Clay bricks are molded, sun-dried, and fired on-site.



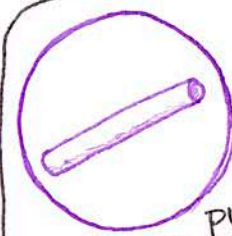
PUMP

Pumps are made in Malawi, Zambia, and Tanzania by MMM-trained Craftsmen from local communities using materials purchased in the region.



CEMENT

Cement is purchased regionally by MMM and distributed to well sites by Field Officers. Each well uses approximately ten bags for construction.



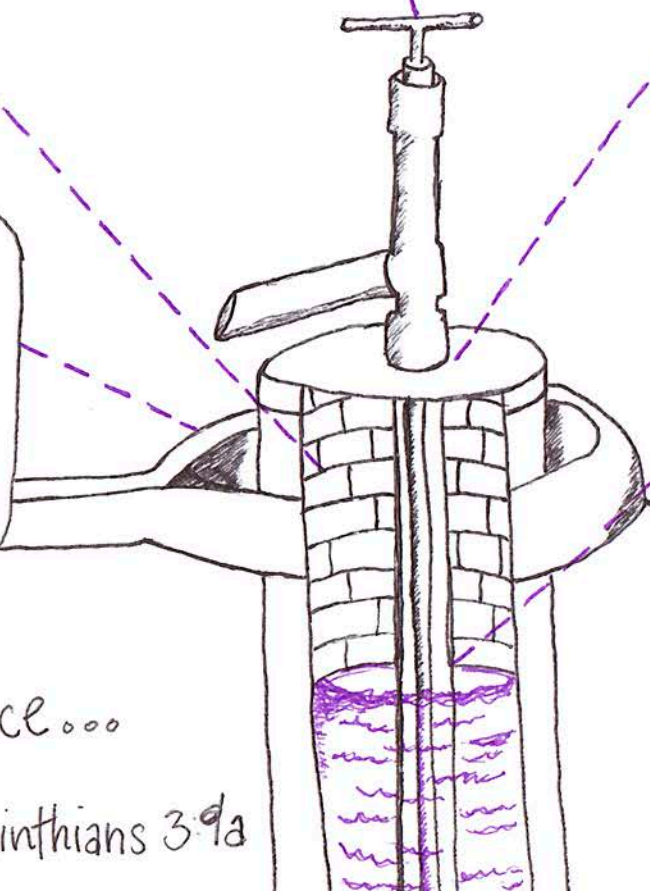
PIPE

PVC Pipe is purchased regionally by MMM, then cut and distributed to each well site by Field Officers.



LABOR

Labor, including gathering materials, digging the well, and mixing the concrete, is done by villagers in partnership with local, MMM-trained builders.
